St. Clare's, Oxford is an International School based in Oxford, UK. Founded in 1953 our mission is "to advance international education and understanding". We have two campuses. The IB World School teaching IB and Pre-IB students (aged 15-18) and the International College (IC) teaching a variety of post-secondary programmes.

We are authorised by the International Baccalaureate Organisation to teach and examine the International Baccalaureate Diploma. You can find more details on these at http://www.stclares.ac.uk/about-us/accreditations/. We have been teaching the IB since 1977.

We are a diverse school with over 50 nationalities on site: 57% European, 30% Rest of World, 11% British, 2% American

IB Curriculum

Students study six subjects, three at standard level (S) and three at higher level (H). Students must have one subject from the subject groups 1-5. For their sixth subject they can study a subject from group 6, or a second subject from any other group. We do not normally allow students to take more than three higher level subjects.

Students are timetabled four 55-minute lessons a week for higher level classes across both years and have an average of three 55-minute lessons a week for standard level subjects.

The maths level students follow is determined by placement tests during the application process and on enrolment.

Alongside their academic subjects, students must complete a course in Theory of Knowledge, their Extended Essay, the CAS program and a PSHE program.

Our internal class and exam grades follow the same grading system as the final IB Diploma. **We do not calculate class rank.**



International College

The St Clare's International College is home to several hundred students each academic year who follow a variety of English language and academic study programmes. In the last 3 years, students from Albania, Belgium, China, France, Germany, Italy, Kazakhstan, the Netherlands, Russia, Spain, Switzerland, Ukraine, and the USA have enrolled on academic courses at the International College.

University Foundation Programme Curriculum

The St. Clare's University Foundation Programme is a post-high school (level 3) qualification established over 10 years ago. Students study intensive academic English for 10 hours per week and choose three of six academic subjects (Business, Economics, Mathematics, Politics, Philosophy or Psychology).

English plus Academic Subjects / Undergraduate Programme

Semester-long courses combining 10 weekly hours of intensive English language for academic purposes with 9 hours of academic subject lessons, taught at undergraduate level. Three courses are chosen from: Business, Economics, Communications, Literature, Mathematics, Social Sciences, Art History and Studio Art, Modern Languages, Philosophy and Religion. Established 30 years ago, the **Undergraduate Programme** is a study-abroad programme for native or near-native speakers of English. Students choose five subject classes (including one tutorial class taught 1:1 or 1:2). The **University of San Diego** acts as the university of credit.
